Bufiles contain no information identifiable with Marion Harrison Lafferty and no information identifiable with Bobby Joe Sorrell.

Louisville immediately prepare LHM reporting results of interview with Lafferty. Bureau notes that on page one of FD-302, paragraph four, the first sentence is actually two sentences. Correct this when preparing LHM.

Indianapolis review files on Lafferty, also on the name Sorrell, and advise Dallas and Bureau.

Dallas review files on Oswald and on the assassination for any information that Oswald was in Muncie, Indiana, in the late Summer of 1963, or at any time.

In view of the observations of Louisville that it appears that Lafferty could possibly be imagining or exaggerating his information, the Bureau desires no investigation of the allegation that Oswald was in Muncie, Indiana, in 1963, unless Dallas finds information tending to substantiate the allegations made by Lafferty. Note that Lafferty has waited more than six years before making his allegation; also that he stated that he felt that the third white male he had seen in the house in Muncie "might have been Oswald." The Bureau notes that Lafferty indicated he has forgotten much of the detail pertinent to his allegation.

NOTE:

Our investigation revealed that Oswald was living in New Orleans in the late Summer of 1963, having moved to New Orleans in April, 1963. In late September, he left New Orleans and visited in Mexico City, and then moved to the Dallas area. There is no information that he was in Muncie, Indiana, during this period. The allegations by Lafferty do not warrant any active investigation unless there is some corroboration for the story concerning Muncie, Indiana.
