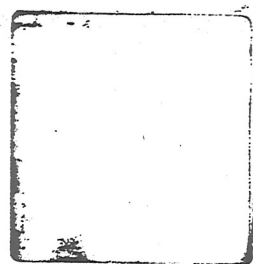

Interview: Interviewed Mrs. Mangum on the job where she is a secretary in Judge Richberg's court located on the second floor of the Oak Cliff Court Building.

Advised she has never worked in the TSBD - never been inside for that matter. She was working her present job about one year in November, 1963 and she and others went to Cedar Springs Road on the 22nd to see the motorcade pass that segment of the publicized JFK route.

Having viewed the President driving by, they were in the process of returning to work via the Stemmons Freeway when they were surprised to see what looked like the President's limousine pass their car. They understood a short time later when they turned the car radio on.

This is the extent of her knowledge, first hand or otherwise at that time.

In response to my question, she has never met "Lonnie Hudkins", but produced a letter she received some time ago from another person she hadn't heard of - a Harold Weisburg. Has no

idea who "Mary" might be. Copy of Weisberg letter dated 8-20-77 will be attached to typed interview.

Eddie Raymond Walthers was her husband's correct name, but "Buddy" had been a consistent nickname.

She knew of Ralph Walters. He worked in the Dallas Sheriff's office with "Buddy" until the latter was shot to death while attempting to capture an escapee in a Dallas hotel several years ago.

She'll check for any old material at home. Did not reply to Weisberg's letter.

Dear Mrs. Mangum:

Our mutual friend, Lonnie Hudkins, who has been working near here for some years, suggests that I write you for the reasons that follow.

If you would care to check me out with Lonnie and have not heard from him or Mary for a while, he can be reached at the Baltimore News-American, Baltimore, Md. While I have not asked his permission, I think Henry Wade would give me a good name.

I am not one of those seeking to make a good thing out of the Kennedy assassination. Rather am I hopeful of bringing to light as much as possible and then making it available.

It has not been possible for me to get to Dallas as often as I'd like or to stay long enough when I am there. Buddy was killed the day before I had planned to look him up. I was on my way in from the airport when it happened.

One of the means by which I obtain suppressed evidence is use of the Freedom of Information Act. If the federal government then does not provide the information, when I can I go to court. I have a case in court now for the results of certain nonsecret scientific tests related to the shooting in the JFK assassination. These results have never been released. It is my belief that the reason is their failure to support the official account of the crime.

One of the items of evidence tested was the curbstone struck by a bullet or fragment of bullet. At the time of the crime, Buddy spoke to Jim Tague, who was slightly wounded. (He lives at 14324 Shoredale if you would care to ask his opinion of me.) The next day Buddy and I believe Allen Sweatt went to that point when pictures were being taken. I have pictures of Buddy's hand holding a pen and using it to point to that spot.

The test performed on that curbstone after it was dug up and taken to Washington is known as spectrographic analysis. The FBI gave no report on this to the Warren Commission and now in court claims not to have any report.

I hope that Buddy had some notes or other records that could be useful in this litigation. This is why I write.

I know he also examined a place on Elm Street where it was believed a bullet hit. He was active in other parts of the investigation. Any records or pictures in any way relating to the crime could be of great value to me and would be much appreciated. In the end they would wind up in a university archive, available to all the American people.

Likewise, if there is any information you have, it could be helpful.

Thank you very much for anything you can do. If making copies is a problem, I am sure Jim Tague would see to it that you have no problems or costs. He can be reached during the day at Steakley's Chevrolet.
