Your letter of 12/23 arrived today. If I forgot to tell you, I have already established a connection between James Hepburn (Herve Lamarre) and a close associate of "Baxley". I cannot say what it means, but I am unwilling to regard it as merely another "coincidence".

For the Press:

Several of those who had close contact with Lamarre will be preparing detailed memos of what they observed, etc. When I get them, if there is anything of worth included, I'll send it to you. However, unless I am prepared to expect nothing further from these sources, I'd prefer that you keep this entirely within your organization.

I want to thank you for your letter of December 20.

In addition, I have asked for help from one in Canada from whom I believe it will be forthcoming. As you may recall, it is from Canada that they plan to distribute the book and, if and when the deal with Stuart goes through, from where they will continue to distribute.

Interested in this matter.
