Phillippe (Philippe). Was ~~not~~ Vesjoly the name of the former French
intelligence chief or at least an agent in US? Would a picture of him be
obtainable? I could then show it to those who cut others than Lemaire, the
only one I know I've met. Other Phillippe: Gerinot, 30 Rue Chapul, Levallois
SE, France. In US early August 1968. October 1968. French agent named Philippe
Boellion said to have been arrested in Manitoba for stirring up French Canadians.

Soroquerne's office 34 Ave. Kléber, Paris, has third man, 6'8", large
frame, 200 lbs., 48 years, dark hair and complexion. Berget 6'8", slightly built,
brown hair, eyes, thin, long face, high forehead, prominent beak, yellow
complexion, talks little, no humor or charm, hard personality. Office plush,
tastefully 18th century decor. Another ex army upstair there.
