## 2 Pilots Held By Miami Police

A bizarre plot to kidnap Jando Masterrer and deliver him to a Cuban firing squad unfolded here Saturday with the arrest of two free-lance pilots.

Police said the pilots were involved in a plan to whisk Masterrer — known as "The Tiger" and the hated executioner of Cuba's deposed dictator — out of his Miami hide-away by a ruse.

Police said the plotters were to be paid \$11,000 and given certain gambling concessions.

A Miami police department intelligence unit, headed by Sgt. Charles Sapp, broke the case with pre-dawn arrests of the two pilots.

They were Walter Youngblood, 28, of 3830 NW 65th Ave. and James C. Grizzle, 32, of 200 SW 38th Ct.

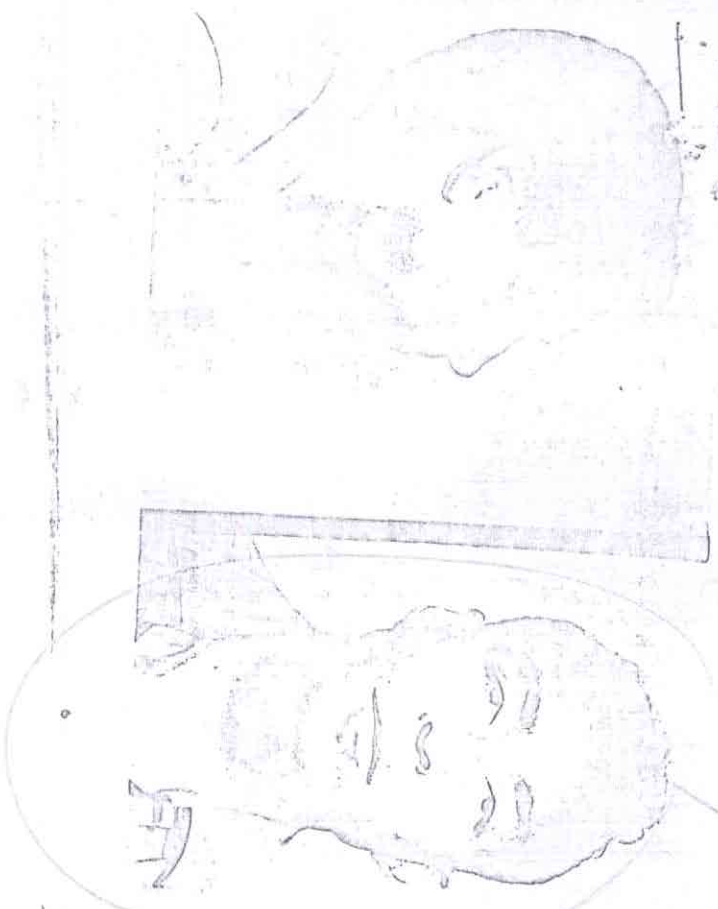
Also sought were other men who were to pose as police or Immigration officers and lure Masterrer. Youngblood is a self-styled
