Dear Chuck,

Enclosed are an addition to the memo I prepared for my lawyer last week, pertaining to the suit for the JFK assassination evidence, and the records referred to in it.

If you have any questions, or interest, please let me know.

As you can see, I'm building cases: that destruction was and was known to be prohibited (whether or not there was destruction); that the reasons given for the alleged destruction are false and were known to be false; and that the FBI was and is covering up.

My lawyer is negotiating with the DJ lawyer on how records I'm getting under an administrative appeals victory will be provided. By May 15 I'm to have new Dallas field office records, including the records on the critics.

I believe I went into the possibilities regarding the curbstone, which is suitable for photographic treatment. With poor facilities I've already done it adequately. Here you will find additional confirmation that all the supposed material was scraped away.

If I didn't tell you, the FBI managed to get rid of the specimen known as Q15, scrapings from the windshield where it was stuck during the assassination.
