Ichord Asks For Check on Move by ACLU

House Internal Security Committee Chairman Richard H. Ichord (D-Mo.), said yesterday he has asked the Internal Revenue Service to decide if the American Civil Liberties Union's bid to abolish his panel "is proper conduct for a tax-exempt organization."

Ichord said the March issue of ACLU's monthly publication announced the group was sponsoring a letter-writing campaign urging Congress to vote against continued existence of HISC, formerly known as the House Un-American Activities Committee.

The House has repeatedly rejected attempts to abolish the committee.
