There is some reason why the Spanish government, which is politically the kind that would like Hunt's view representing us, would not accept him yet thereafter employed his wife. Is there any indication on this? It could have significance. I won't now call Hanarahan to ask him about this but when we talk I may ask him what he may know. The Post has made no mention of any of this. I know Hike enjoys a good rep., but the one thing he did of which I know he loused up so professionally and so needlessly that ' have wondered since. As I did about Billings sending him, of all people. I'd be suspicious of Bud's enlisting Sould's help in tracking anyone, but if he does, I think it could be good if I were there.
