Prefers Wallace Views

LOS ANGELES, Oct. 10 (UPI)—A spokesman for the Afro-American Citizen's Council here said today former Alabama Gov. George Wallace was the only presidential candidate who offers the black community the "economic and political unity" it needs to survive.

Ernie Smith told a news conference Wallace had "the philosophy and attitude to make Negroes stand up for themselves instead of waiting for some kind of Messiah."

Smith said his group favored Wallace's candidacy because it believed Negroes should not have to live in an integrated society unless they wanted to.
