REP. BOGGS: Mr. Chief Justice, who sees this transcript

CHAIRMAN: That is supposed to be Top Secret, between the reporter and this Commission, and no one else. I am sure that is the understanding.

REP. BOGGS: All right.

CHAIRMAN: We could not have less than that.

REP. BOGGS: I just wanted to make sure.

MR. DULLES: Mr. Chairman, I was just wondering, Mr. Xatzenbach made a specific recommendation in his letter that, I think, none of us would like to go through with. On the other hand, he said, I think, therefore, the Commission should consider releasing - or allowing the Department of Justice to release a short press statement which would preferably make the following points. Now, I wonder if we don't have to do something about that.
