I have studied Commission No. 48(c) which is an FBI report dealing with the Dallas bus routes. Since the survey Oswald's actions after the assassination represent an important aspect of your area, I feel that some attempt should be made to evaluate why Oswald did what he did.

It is hard to figure out why Oswald took the bus which route is described on the first page of 48(c). In order to have reached his rooming house on N. Wootley Street, he would have had to transfer to one of several other buses at either Transfer Point 74 (Howard and Dan), Transfer Point 75 (Main and Houston) or Transfer Point 94 (Commerce and Eastern). All three of these transfer points are as close or closer to the Texas School Bus Depository than the point at which Oswald presumably boarded the bus which was approximately 7 blocks from the scene of the assassination.

In addition to the transfer points mentioned above, Oswald might have transferred at Transfer Point 77 which is located at a point not far from his rooming house. It would, as I can determine, however, there is no bus route running from this transfer point to his rooming house.

If my analysis of these bus routes is correct, it would appear that Oswald was either heading for a location other than his rooming house or that his behavior was quite erratic. I would suggest that you study these bus routes and discuss them with us at your earliest convenience.
