Under date of December 31, 1963, the Houston Office advised that LOHNIE WOMINS, reporter for the Houston Post Newspaper at Houston, Texas, had advised SA JAMES W. FISSELL on December 31, 1969, that in his conversations with RUTH. PAIME, the socially prominent Ft. Worth woman referred to was LINDA ROSENTHAL who lives in the 4800 Block of Oram Street, Ft. Worth, Texas.

EUDXINS advised that Mrs. ROSENTHAL had employed Mrs. OSWALD in September and October 1962, and that ROSENTHAL had previously been interviewed by the FBI.

HUDKINS concluded by stating he was on a"fishing expedition"and was attempting to determine if LEE HARVEY OSWALD had been a "stool pigeon" for some government agency such as CIA or the FBI.
