The following Warren Commission documents allude to FBI and Secret Service investigations of the report that Lee Harvey Oswald was an "agent" and the connection of Alonzo Rudkins and Joseph Goulden with the rumors: CD87, folder 5, Control No. 640; CD385:106; and CD463.

Are there any other FBI, Secret Service, or CIA reports of such investigations?

These reports, as supplied me, have no copies of the pertinent stories written by these reporters. If they are in the files, I would like copies.

CD385:106 makes reference to the interview of FBI SA James W. Russell with Rudkins. I would like a copy of that report, which was not included in what was sent me. It also refers to the possible interview of Mrs. Linda Rosenthal of Fort Worth, which I would like. There is an inference that Mrs. Ruth Paine may have been interviewed on this subject. If she was, I would appreciate a copy of that interview.
