I am also interested in locating a letter written by F.B.I. Director J. Edgar Hoover on May 26, 1964 (GAI-FBI) which mentioned a 1954 or '55 Packard sedan with Arizona license FZY 958. Would you let me know if there is a copy of this, a report about it, or a mention of it in any of the Commission documents? If not, would you tell me how such information could be located?

Additionally, there are two pieces of information mentioned in one of the Commission documents (the last page of Stern's memo to Rankin, Feb. 10, 1964, [GAI-CIA]) which I am interested in. Would you please send me a list, by document file number and page number, of any additional memos about, references to, or mentions of the following:

1. C.I.A. advised F.B.I. that Oswald had contacted the Soviet Embassy in Mexico City on Oct. 1, 1963.
2. An F.B.I. agent told two Secret Service agents on Nov. 22, 1963, that Oswald had, within the past 15 days, contacted two known subversive agents.

I appreciate any help you can give me with the information I am seeking.
