Hudkins said he went to Dallas in December, 1963, to check out such rumors based on information he received from Assistant Dallas County District Attorney Alexander to effect Oswald's address book contained name and phone number of SA Hootby. Hudkins said he also interviewed Oswald's mother who said Oswald was doing subversive work for U. S. He also alleged a local official told him Oswald was an FBI or CIA informant.
