Basis for investigation is petition filed by the SUBJECT'S husband, LEE HARVEY OSWALD, to classify her as a nonquota immigrant. Object of investigation to secure evidence upon which to base decision regarding waiver of sanctions imposed under Section 243(g) of the Act.

Petitioner has resided in Russia since 1959 and emigrated to that country

because of dislike for the United States.

Interview of petitioner's brother, R. L. OSWALD, disclosed no evidence that petitioner was ever a member of the Communist Party. Investigation conducted by the Federal Bureau of Investigation likewise did not establish Communist Party membership of petitioner.

United States birth of petitioner established. Local police checks negative

on petitioner.

State Department reports show petitioner has not lost United States citizenship and will probably have passport revalidated for direct return to the United States. State Department also reports definite change in petitioner's attitude toward United States, indicating he now appreciates freedom and his native country.
