

Marine Corps records have been expunged to hide the fact that Lee Harvey Oswald, accused assassin~~et~~ of President John F. Kennedy, had a top TOP SECRET security clearance.

Two independent examination of those records, the first at the time Oswald supposedly defected to Russia and the second as soon as he was arrested in Dallas after the assassination, disclosed no indication of Oswald's havinvgany security clearance at all.

When the Warren Commission, appointed by President Lyndon Baines Johnson, to investigate that "crime of the centeruy," gathered in such secrecy it did not permit any members of its staff to be present

The Warren Commission received a report that Texas officials heard that Oswald had been an informant. It was so terrified it discussed this report in such secrecy it kept its staff out and never informed it. ~~to Texas~~ It thought it destroyed all records of this deliberation, ~~but~~ In fact, it feared that "people" would "think that there was a conspiracy to accomplish this assassination that nothing the Commission did or anybody could dissipate."

All of this and much more I obtained under the Freedom of Information Act. It is the new official position that nothing embarrassing to the government has been brought to light through FOIA, that all the embarrassing information has been disclosed voluntarily. ~~What was reported above was~~ All of what I now disclosed, except where otherwise indicated, was obtained under FOIA, ~~and~~ ^{It} had been withheld for many years, even after I sought the suppressed information under FOIA. The most recent of this information did not reach me until December, 1981, and then in response to a 1977 request.
