Lloyd J. Cobb, president of the International Trade Mart, testified that he knew Shaw's whereabouts at all times during the period in 1963 when Garrison said the assassination plot was hatched. N.O. States-Item 22 Feb 69

Mr. Cobb testified [21 Feb 69] that Mr. Shaw worked steadily, sometimes late into the night, during all of August and September, 1963, except for Sept. 25, when he went to Hammond, La., to visit his parents.
