Agnew Choice of Paper Criticized by Guild

Vice President Agnew's choice of the struck Los Angeles Herald-Examiner as one of four newspapers permitted to have a representative accompany him to Asia was protested yesterday by the presidents of the American Newspaper Guild and its Los Angeles local.

In a telegram to Agnew, ANG President Charles A. Perlik, Jr. and Los Angeles Newspaper Guild President Nicholas Abraham charged that choice of the newspaper, which has been operating for more than 2½ years with strickbreakers is a "slap in the face to the striking and locked-out Herald-Examiner employees and the thousands of other workers in Los Angeles and across the nation who have steadfastly supported their struggle to preserve their self-respect, their unions and their jobs."
