I've skished the worksheets and have the impression that there are duplicates. If you are missing any, it will be a hell of a job to retrieve the dupes.

They confirm what I'we said often, that Blakey corrupted the investigation to attempt to validate his preconceptions and avoided what does not conform to those preconceptions.

On the question of ticklers, however, they are very important in that they prove that the FBi's attestations in the field offices case are lies and were known to be lies (and deliberate misrepresentations) when attested to. This would be even note important if Phillips is the supervisor in mark's case. Here, five years after there is no MACA, the ticklers are still intact. Most has no relevance to the linguishing matters.

A few of the things hight be of some interest and I do not recall getting them, although it is possible I did. Identifying them from the worksheets is not easy because they are not numbered. And often are partly illegible, limit the first below:

HSCA dated 4/83, "Blue Book Invest of killing of Oswald," 19 79 pc disclosed and "in resding room."

730 a dated 6/83, last item #19, item above it a 94-94-3-316, 2 pp.

HSCA dated Sept. 1983, narrower lines, File No. 94-49878. Total about 53 pp. I'm interested in all 94s.

130A dated Sept 1985, File No. 94-61810, two items. 14 pp.

HSCA dated 10-83, "administrative Folders FOIPA EBF's and Bulkies Project," cover and 4 pp.

ASCa dated 10/53, "Administrative Folders Title: GaO Report re its Review of FM Indexes." Four items, all but cover withheld as "Not Sub. TO FOIA." Legal't this published and how is it now subject to FOIA? We should read this, all of us.

HDCA dated Scot. 1983, File No. 94-61810, 2 items, 14 pp.

HECA duted 11/83, File No. "administrative Folders, Pitle President's Corrassion-Assassination of John F. Kennedy Index." cover and 18 pp.
