Dear Mr. Garrison:

While I attended the World Conference of Lawyers in Geneva last month, I went down to Rome to discuss with certain Vietnamese there the events which led up to the assassination of Premier Diem and his brother early in November of 1963.

The information which I received, and which was never reported in the American press, tempts me very strongly to think that there was a connection between the assassination of Diem and his brother, and the assassination of President Kennedy just three weeks later. If you have someone here whom you can authorize in writing to speak for you, I shall be glad to discuss it with him. Of course, if you should be here yourself, I should be glad to go into it with you.

If it should later be desirable for me to come to New Orleans, I shall be quite willing to do so.
