On 9-17-63 Oswald obtained a 16-day Mexican Tourist Card from the Mexican Consulate, New Orleans. The signature on the card and the handwriting on the application have been identified by the Laboratory as Oswald's writing. Oswald is believed to have 1 eft Ne. Orleans on the morning of 9-25-63 en route to Laredo, Texas, by bus. Details of his travel from New Orleans to Laredo have ndy'as yet been determined. On the afternoon of 9-26-63 he entered Mexico at Nuevo Larede. Mexican Immigration officials there could figrish no information of value. However, records of the Flecha ola (Red Arrow), a Mexican bus line, disclosed that oswald was on 1 ed Arrow bus 516 which departed Nuevo Laredo 2 Dame, 9-26 entroute Mexico City.
