Weisberg's labyrinth of illogic and syntax SNAFUs says nill.

Harold Weisberg writes like an angry parent scolding a wayward child. Gerald Posner used Weisberg's extensive library in his research for "Case Closed" and then had the audacity to disagree with Weisberg's conspiracy beliefs. Weisberg is virtually impossible to read.
