<u>City and State</u> 2 Canadians Held For Deportation

Immigration officials arrested two Canadians yesterday at the Headquarters of the National Socialist White People's Party in Arlington, saying they were working illegally at Ft. Myer, Va.

Being held by the U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Service here for deportation proceedings are James P. Friesen, 24, of Vancouver, B.C., and Thomas Sophonow, 18, of Grand Forks, B.C.

Immigration officials said the two carried cards indentifying them as members of the party, formerly called the American Nazi Party.

Friesen and Sophonow were working as stewards in a cafeteria at Ft. Myer. To obtain employment in this country, a Canadian citizen must obtain permission from the U.S. government.
