Stink Bomb Suspect Is Charged

A member of the Nationalist Socialist White People's Party, formerly the American Nazi Party, was charged by the Corporation Counsel yesterday with four counts of disorderly conduct in connection with the three recent stink bombings at the Warner Theater.

The suspect, Michael J. Gauss, 22, of 2815 N. Thurst., Arlington, was arrested May 29 at the theater, where "Slaves" is playing. Police charged that he was opening a bottle of bomb mixture when arrested.

A burglary charge originally brought against Gauss was dropped last week in the Court of General Sessions. The first of the three stink bombings occurred May 23.
