Bottle-Throwing Ends Rally by Nazi Group

One person was injured during a confrontation yesterday between 25 members of the National Socialist White People's Party and about 200 jeering young persons in L'Enfant Square, 9th Street and Constitution Avenue NW.

Party members were granted a permit by park police to hold a rally in the square from 1:30 p.m. until 4:30 p.m. However, when jeers and bottles were hurled by party members and by their youthful audience, park Police

Lt. R. R. Kerzaya revoked the permit on the spot at about 4 p.m., he said later.

A bystander was hit by a bottle, and was treated at George Washington University Hospital and released.

Park police, on horseback and on foot, escorted party members to their vehicles. They drove off at 4:15 p.m., amid more jeers and epithets.
