Gordon Hall has been analyzing and investigating political fringe groups for nearly 20 years. A unique crusader for social and political sanity, his research on the political fringes has brought retaliation through physical attacks, threatening phone calls and continuous harassment. Mr. Hall keeps track of the many fringe groups largely by taking advantage of their eagerness to mail out literature. He frequently attends meetings and rallies, obtaining information firsthand. His research ranges from the Marxist extreme left, across the broad democratic middle and on out to the brutal terrorists of the Ku Klux Klan on the radical right. **The Saturday Evening Post** published his life story and in 1964, he was the special guest of Walter Cronkite on "The Twentieth Century." From the lecture platform, Mr. Hall carefully distinguishes between the constructive liberal and conservative and the destructive forces representing the extremism of the radical left and the radical right. He is an effective speaker, eminently fair and knows how to handle hecklers. It is his opinion that free discussion is the only way for the truth to emerge. He has no official backing, no funds save what he can earn as a lecturer. What he does have is a firm belief in what he is doing, unshakable determination and a great deal of quiet courage. Gordon Hall is unquestionably the top authority in his field; and, he has dedicated his efforts, his money and his life toward the protection and preservation of our democratic government.


