DONALD GATCH, M.D.

The crusading young South Carolina doctor whose personal efforts are having a major effect on coming legislation for a program that will help eradicate malnutrition and starvation in rural areas of the U.S.



JAMES GERMANO

27 year old Director of Marathon House, a "tribe-like paternalistic community" for the rehabilitation of drug addicts. A former addict, Mr. Germano has achieved a spectacular success, and the respect of professional and non-professional groups.



VERA GLASER

Washington Bureau Chief for the North American Newspaper Alliance, Miss Glaser covers all government news centers, the White House, and news of particular interest to women. She is a frequent guest on *Meet the Press*.



REP. CURTIS GRAVES

One of the three negroes who integrated the Texas legislature, and whose bills are being passed although two years ago he was snubbed by white colleagues. He now represents a responsible force in Texas politics.



FATHER JAMES GROPPi

One of the first religious figures to take an active part in the Civil Rights movement, he has been a militant leader of demonstrations, and is an impressive spokesman who continues his Civil Rights fight in his home state of Wisconsin.



VICTOR RIESEL
The heroic labor news columnist, the author of *Who's Who in America*, Mr. Riesel continues his career in underworld and Communist infiltration of labor unions.



W.D. SNODGRASS
A leading poet, and a professor of English. Mr. Snodgrass is a writer with a special gift of communication whether reading his poetry, teaching, or talking with his audience.



CONG. CHARLES L. WELLNER
The congressman who said, in October 1966: "I will give up my office before I give up my principles." His story of political courage of an un-political decision. He is running for politics as candidate for Mayor of Atlanta.



JOHN ROCK, M.D.
Clinical Professor of Gynecology Emeritus, Harvard Medical School. He is the medical representative of the U.S. in Hanoi. He is the recipient of the Nobel Award of the Planned Parenthood Federation in America and other citations.



THOMAS C. SORENSEN
Author of *The World War: The Story of American Propaganda*, former USA Diplomat in California at Berkeley. He speaks on *Bad Day at Generation Gap*.



IVY WEIRMONT
One of the more talented free-lance teachers — from mental disciplines that develop an eloquent memory — to generally inspirational talks of interest to schools, colleges, religious groups and fraternal organizations.



DR. JERRY ROSENBERG

REP. LEWIS STOKES
First black legislator from Ohio, and first black legislator named to the House Un-American Activities Committee.

JERRY RUBIN
Project director of the October '67 demonstration at the Pentagon, member of the Vietnam Day Committee in Berkeley (where he ran for mayor and received 20% of the vote); is presently under indictment by Federal Grand Jury for conspiracy to cause riots at the Democratic Convention.



GERALD SCHARFLANDER
One of the most exciting speakers in America, instructor of Sociology at Boston University, and author of *Chloe Child* lives in the ghetto as an activist. He is the poet of the ghetto and the whites out of the ghetto will solve nothing!



I. THOMAS UNGERLEIDER, M.D.
Assistant Professor of Psychiatry, UCLA Medical Center in Los Angeles, has written *Psychedelic Experience* with the U.S. Army, Ford Ord, California. He has made special studies into the side effects of LSD.



MIGUEL RUMBO
Protégé of Segovia, has been acclaimed by American students during four tours of colleges and universities. He offers impressive selections of classical Spanish guitar compositions.



ANNE SEXTON
Pulitzer Prize winning poetess, and performer of her most dramatic and revealing verse. Her latest book, *Love Poems* was published in spring 1968.



KURT VONNEGUT, JR.
Science-fiction writer, author of *Slaughterhouse Five*, *The Sirens of Titan*, and *Welcome to the Monkey House*. This great modern satirist lectures on the problems of ethical men of science such as the virtuous physicians who refused to work on weapons development.



MARK RIDD
Editor of *SOS*, and the student idea at Columbia University, a brilliant student who finds that the student side of the story be heard.



ALBERT SHANKER
President of the United Federation of Teachers; Board of Trustees—Center for Urban Education; and numerous educational organizations.



HOWARD ZINN
Boston University professor, author, advocate of the causes of racial equality, draft resistance and Vietnam withdrawal. Zinn, a WWII bombardier, campaigns against all aspects of American bombing in Vietnam.



JAMES HENRY
Author of *The New Politics* (the politics of manipulation), and Senior editor of the *National Observer*.



ROGER PRICE
Publisher of *How To Be A Jewish Mother*, writer, actor, and cartoonist. Roger Price is funny about everything from Antiphanes to elephants — but especially about himself, the man next door, and you.



CHARLES QUINN
The NBC political correspondent who has traveled many a campaign trail. He has watched candidates of both parties for over two decades, and is an astute observer of the political American.



MAX RAFFERTY
Superintendent and Director of Public Education in California, one of the most controversial educators in the U.S.



HARRY ESKAY
Mc. Eskay is a man for all media, and has won every award given for television and radio in North America. His most recent Emmy winner was *Hall of Kings*, a drama-documentary of Westminster Abbey.



PHAM KHAC RAU

MARLENE SANDERS

DAVID SEAVITT/HENRY SUTTON
Two names, two names, but one writer. **HENRY SUTTON** writes books (*The Eritrionist* and *The Joyce*) that support the poet and talented writer **DAVID SEAVITT**, a successful and legitimate system for both.



GAY TALESE
Author of *The Kingdom and The Power*, the definitive history of the New York Times. Mr. Talese is a popular name in magazines and newspapers and has appeared regularly in all leading publications.



ROBERT THORNBALD
Author of *An Alternative Future for America*, and member of the Columbia University Seminar on Technology and Social Change. Mr. Thornbald is a brilliant theorist, popular in student circles. He has written the New Right (the New Left (which is the same) according to Mr. Thornbald).



RICHARD WALTON

Former Press Secretary to President Dwight D. Eisenhower, he is now Vice President in charge of Corporate Relations for the American Broadcasting Companies, Inc.



GORDON HALL
Research specialist and authority on political fringe movements that conduct out freethink, extremism is a member of the 69's.



ANDREW HATCHER
Former Associate Press Secretary to President John F. Kennedy, Mr. Hatcher has been a CIVIL RIGHTS leader since the days when the movement was nameless. His was an influential voice in formulating the CIVIL RIGHTS policy of the New Frontier.



DR. ROBERT HAVIGHURST
Research Scientist in the field of social and biology of child development, and education of gifted children, Dr. Havighurst is Chairman of the Department of Education and Human Development, Univ. Chicago.



DR. ALBERT HIBBS
Science editor of NBC, Senior Staff Scientist of NASA's Jet Propulsion Laboratory, Dr. Hibbs helped develop Space Satellites and the TV camera for lunar exploration.



RUSSELL KIRK
Author of *The Conservative Mind*, Mr. Kirk is the foremost conservative thinker in Europe and North America.



JONATHAN KOZOL
Author of *Death At An Early Age*, and a prize winning first novel, *The Fame of Popper*, Mr. Kozol is dedicated to a personal crusade for better education in ghetto schools.



GAIL KUBIK
Winner of the Prix de Rome, Pulitzer Prize and an Academy Award, Mr. Kubik has an international background among the young avant-garde musicians. He gives his full support to the "new" music, its unfamiliar sounds, and its importance in the cultural revolution.



MARK LANE
Attorney, and author of *Path to Assassination*, and publication *Path to Assassination*, detailed circumstances of the Kennedy assassination. *Chicago Eye Witness*, 1968, reports on demonstrations during the 1968 Democratic convention.



DR. KALVIN LAPP
Scientist, author of *The Weapon Culture*, and one of the group of Manhattan Project scientists. Dr. Lapp gives a comprehensive lecture on "the weapons culture" in America, the involvement of our universities in government armaments and defense projects, and many other pertinent aspects of our technological society.



JOHN LEWIS
Former Director of SNCC, Lewis remains committed to a policy of structured change, and has earned Hank Power. He will always be one of the most remembered men of the 1960 sit-ins, and 1961 freedom rides.



ROLLO MAY, M.D.
Psychoanalyst, author and leader of the existential school of psychoanalysis.



MERCEDES McCAMBRIDGE
Presents the Sarah Siddons Interpretation of the most memorable female characters from Shakespeare's comedies and tragedies. Miss McCambridge is an actor-actor in every respect.



SHEPHERD MEAD
Author of *How to Succeed in Business Without Really Trying*, escaped from a career on Madison Avenue that was more material for his best editor, from his time in England in *How to Live Like a Lord Without Really Trying*.



FRANCOIS MITTERRAND
Leader of the non-Communist Federation of the (French) Left, was narrowly defeated by De Gaulle in 1964. He continues to be an active and formative political figure, and candidate to the Gaullist regime.



DR. ASHLEY MONTAGU
Anthropologist, writer, and lecturer; author of *The Making of Man*, *Being Human*, *Man's Power*, and dozens of published papers. *The Natural Superiority of Women* is one of his most requested lectures.



DAY TYLER MOORE
Former chief of the OSS in Cairo, Egypt, he has applied the WWII talent and training to tracking down some of our more colorful friends and imposters. He speaks on *Spy Warfare and Espionage*.



CALVIN HOFFMAN
Shakespearean scholar, and author of *The Murder of the Man Who Was Socrates*, a major survey to the greatest literary mystery in history.



CECELIA HOLLAND
Author of four historical novels, Miss Holland is the youngest and most prolific writer in this field. She is a superb researcher, as well as a unique and talented young writer.



ABBIE HOFFMAN
Leader of the YIPPIES, and author of *Revolution for the Hell of It*. The Hoffman philosophy is by no means frivolous, it is one man's truth about student protest and other phenomena.



ROY INNIS
National Director of CORE, and brilliant debater on topics that concern Black Power, separatism in the ghetto community, and Community Self-Determination — an Alternative to Chaos.



MAYNARD H. JACKSON, JR.
The young black attorney who unsuccessfully ran against Sen. Herman Talmadge of Georgia. He has demonstrated a keen sense of social justice and will continue to be the first black mayor of a major southern city.



HERMAN KAHN
Consulting scientist to top level government agencies. Director of the Hudson Institute, political analyst; author of many technical books on thermonuclear war, escalation, and Vietnam. Author of *Year 2000*.



GABRIEL LONGO
Author of *Spinal Priest* and himself a former priest, he analyzes the culture which he says, signals of a new age. He says, produces immature adults. His topic: *After Growing Up*.



FR. FRANCIS LITGAS
Pivotal teacher. Literary critic, and African scholar, he analyzes the work of contemporary black American poets, dramatists, and novelists.



NANA MAHOMO
Leader of the historic March on Capetown, this "excellent man" lives in exile in Geneva, writing his book on the revolution in South Africa. He read law at Grey's Inn, London, and received his doctorate at M. I. T.



MAXWELL MALTZ, M.D.
Author of *Psycho Cybernetics*, and contributor to Reader's Digest of articles that include *Your Built-In Secret Mechanisms*, and related topics.



FRANK MANKIEWICZ
A career journalist, newspaper editor, syndicated columnist, and attorney. During the White House years of Sen. Robert Kennedy, Mr. Mankiewicz was active in Democratic politics.



PAMELA MASON
Actress, star of stage, screen and television. Miss Mason is also a writer who is well qualified to speak on the subject of *Life After Marriage*. She is a witty and beautiful guest lecturer and opinion maker.



JAMES MORLEY
Leading authority on UFO's, and founder of the Saucer and Unexplained Celestial Events Research Society. He is also the editor of Saucer News.



KAY MUNGO
Founder of the *Liberation News Service*, the student underground news service being used by nearly every college newspaper in America, as well as several major metropolitan dailies.



DR. FERENC NAGY
Former Prime Minister of Hungary. Dr. Nagy is an authority on Soviet and Communist affairs, both from his background in Hungary and his studies in Washington. He is one of the most widely traveled observers of the world scene.
