Court Requests Andrews Film

An order has been issued by Criminal District Court directing news directors of three television stations to produce all film tape and voice records of Dean A. Andrews Jr. for the office of the district attorney by 10 a.m. Friday.

The order, requested by Assistant District Attorney James L. Alcock and signed by Judge Bernard J. Bagert, is the latest action leading up to Andrews'

action leading up to Andrews' perjury trial Wednesday.

The order was directed to news directors of WWL-TV, WDSU-TV and WVUE-TV. In the application for the writ, Alcock said the state needs the material to prepare its case against Andrews, who is charged with perjury in the Kennedy assassination probe festimony before the Orleans Parish Grand Jury.
