Re Bureau telephone call from Supervisor [redacted] 7/19/76, and Dallas telephone call to Supervisor [redacted] at FBI Headquarters, 7/19/76.

Re Bureau telephone call instructed Dallas review references in captioned case concerning FRANK ANTHONY STURGIS, whose true name is FRANK FLORINI and references on WALLY WESTON, who were recently in the news.

FRANK STURGIS has alleged that JACK RUBY and FIDEL CASTRO allegedly met in Havanah, Cuba, ten weeks before the assassination and discussed arms purchases for Cuba.

WALLY WESTON, who worked at JACK RUBY's Carasel Club until about September, 1963, is alleged to have recently stated that JACK RUBY and LEE HARVEY OSWALD knew each other. On 7/19/76, Supervisor [redacted] at FBI Headquarters was informed that the report of MANNING C. CLEMENTS dated 11/30/63, at Dallas, Texas, in the JACK L. RUBY case (44-1639-644) contained interviews on pages 514 to 516 of SHARI ANGEL WESTON, aka SHARI ANGEL, the wife of WALLY WESTON and on pages 781 to 783, there was reflected an interview with WALLY WESTON on 11/24/63. Supervisor [redacted] was informed that Dallas airtel to Bureau dated 5/28/75 (89-43-9521) contained information wherein SHARI ANGEL, wife of WALLY WESTON, from whom she is now divorced, had alleged she was interviewed by FBI Agents recently in Los Angeles on a wide range of topics, which was established to be untrue.

The Bureau also asked for recommendation as to whether interviews should be conducted with FLORINI and WESTON. It was recommended that both of these individuals, who were believed to be in Miami, Florida area, be interviewed, inasmuch as their recent statements in the news media do not conform with the information they furnished immediately after the assassination.
