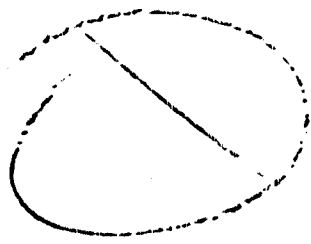

MISCELLANEOUS - INFORMATION CONCERNING

On 5/30/75, an individual who identified himself as H. LARDNER with the Washington Post, called and referred to the article in the Dallas Times Herald of 5/22/75, indicating that the FBI had interviewed SHARI ANGEL, the stripper, earlier that week in Los Angeles. I advised MR. LARDNER that the FBI had not interviewed SHARI ANGEL, as indicated in the Dallas Times Herald article and that if he cared to get any further details, I suggested he call the Dallas Times Herald for any further information as to how they happened to print this particular story. It is noted that the current Executive Editor, KENNETH P. JOHNSON, of the Dallas Times Herald, recently came to the Times Herald from the Washington Post.
