THOSE WHO DID NOT ENTIRELY AGREE WITH HIS POLICIES CONCERNING
CUBA, THE FEELING IS THAT HIS DEATH REPRESENTS GREAT LOSS NOT
ONLY TO US BUT ALL LATIN AMERICA. NO UNAUTHORIZED ACTION AGAINST
CUBA KNOWN TO BE PLANNED.
