The governor's letter was dated June 5 but was distributed to newsmen Monday.

Connally suggested to Gov. John J. McKeithen that the return of Sergio Arcacha Smith for questioning in Gar-rison's investigation "be ac-complished through the use of procedures provided in the uniform act to secure attendance of witnesses from without the state."

"Pending final disposition of your request pursuant to this act, your request for extradition of Sergio Arcacha Smith is being retained on my docket Connally without prejudice," wrote.

McKeithen formally requested Arcacha's extradition to face charges of conspiring to commit burglary.

But at a hearing May 22 before Texas Secretary of State John Hill, Connally's extradition officer, Arcacha's lawyers contended the real reason for the extradition request is to bring Arcacha back to Louisiana for questioning in the Garrison investigation.

Copies of Connally's letter went to Garrison and Vail M. Delony, speaker of the Iouisiana House.
