Interest by Russians Linked to LSD Tests

SAN FRANCISCO, Oct. 9 (UPI)--Res ports that the Soviet Union bought=50 million doses of LSD from a Swiss laboratory touched of fa series: of United States Army tests with the drug, it was disclosed today.

Documents obtained under the Freedom of Information Act by laywers fora former soldier interrogated by the Army with LSD mentioned that the Soviet Union was experimenting with 50million units it had bought from the Swiss lab.

The documents, however, did not detail Soviet interest in the hallucinatory drug. But they indicated that Russian. interest in LSD prompted the Army Intelling gence Board and the Chemical Laboratory to begin experiments in 1955.

On Friday, James Thornwell, 40 years i old, of Oakland, Calif., said that white he was a soldier in 1961 he was given a LSD without his knowledge as part of asarmy interrogation in Europe that left, him psychologically disabled.

According to one document about the, United States response to Soviet interests in LSD, the Army gave doses two to four times the normal amount needed for maximum effect.
