1. References:

a. Defense Investigative Service (DIS) letter, dated 17 April 1975 explaining the systems and procedures utilized to recover personal and impersonal information from the Defense Central Index of Investigations (DCII).

b. Your letter, dated 18 June 1977, requesting additional records pertaining to the assassination of President Kennedy and any Army investigative file or other investigative file concerning yourself. Your request was received in this office on 22 June 1977.

2. This agency is responsible for the custody of all intelligence investigative files generated by the US Army and as revealed in previous correspondence, exhaustive searches of records maintained at this facility, concerning your request, have revealed a "NO RECORD" status. The system and procedures utilized to locate personal and impersonal files within the Investigative Records Repository (IRR) is exactly the same as explained to you in reference a.

3. In regard to your original request, we will continue to process referral material, as received from other agencies.

4. In view of the fact that we have furnished to you all available information held by this agency, regarding your request, it is our desire that this letter will obviate the need for further correspondence regarding this matter.
