Ex-Green Beret's Arsenal Raided

BURLINGTON TOWNSHIP, N.J., Sept. 18 (UPI) — A former Green Beret has been arrested on charges of having enough explosives stored in the apartment house where he lives to demolish the whole building.

Police Chief John W. Lane said detectives who raided William Clay's apartment found 13 blasting caps in a closet. Other munitions, including 4½ pounds of high explosive, two packs of mortar propellant charges and four smoke grenades, were found in a box in the basement of the apartment house.
