Assassination Kits TAMPA, Fla. — Frank Seeley, a Fort Myers gun-smith charged with manufac-turing "assassination kits," has been sentenced to 22 years in federal prison.

U.S. District Judge Gerald U.S. District Judge Gerald B. Tjoflat, who passed sent-ence, said, "We have a case where people were making weapons to assassinate peo-ple — like judges, officials and citizens." Seeley, 38, was convicted last October of 18 violations of firearms laws in the man-ufacture of black attache cases fitted with sawed-off rifles and silencers.
