In November of 1991, 400 concerned citizens from 30 states and 5 nations convened at Dallas' Hyatt Regency Hotel at Reunion Square, blocks away from Dealey Plaza. Their purpose as participants in **ASK: Assassination Symposium on John F. Kennedy** was to further the dialogue about Kennedy's assassination and the mysteries that continue to elude assassination researchers.

Building on this solid foundation, ASK '92 will offer four days of new panel discussions, intensive group workshops, and other special events related to assassination research. This second Symposium will continue the effort to convince the United States government to make public all evidence that is currently sealed and reopen an inquiry into the assassination.
