Remembering JFK's death

There will be no Arlington Cemetery graveside services, nothing at Boston's JFK library or Washington's Kennedy Center, but media attention on the 25th anniversary of President John F. Kennedy's death includes:

BOOKS ▶ *Final Disclosure: The Full Truth About the Assassination of President Kennedy*, by David W. Belin, counsel to the Warren Commission. A defense of the commission's position that Oswald was the lone killer. (Scribner, \$19.95)

▶ *Promises to Keep*, by George Bernau. Kennedy survives an assassination attempt to serve a second term — and face a second



gunman. (Warner, \$19.95)

▶ *The Way We Were: 1963 The Year Kennedy Was Shot*, by Robert McNeil of *McNeil/Lehrer Newshour*. A look at the year's political and cultural impact. (Carroll & Graff, \$39.95)

▶ *Life in Camelot*, *Life* magazine's tribute to JFK. A coffee-table keepsake with more than 500 photos tracing JFK's life. (Little Brown, \$40)

Life also reissues the November 1963 memorial edition of the magazine (\$3.95), the only time the *Life* cover logo changed from red to black.

▶ *Let The Word Go Forth*, a compilation of JFK's words by friend and adviser Theodore C. Sorensen, with first-time political disclosures. (Delacorte, \$25)

TV ▶ *In His Own Words*. Documentary narrated mostly by JFK himself. (HBO, debuts Nov. 6, check local listings for days and time)

▶ *Who Shot President Kennedy?* *Nova* hosts a debate of whether Lee Harvey Oswald was JFK's lone assassin. (PBS, Nov. 15, check local listings)

▶ *CBS Reports*. Dan Rather anchors a two-hour documentary on the life and death of JFK. Rather's 1963 coverage sent him to the big time. (CBS, Nov. 17)

▶ *JFK Assassination: As It Happened*. A six-hour, minute-by-minute rebroadcast of NBC's coverage. (Arts & Entertainment cable network, Nov. 22)

▶ *On Trial: Lee Harvey Oswald*. A five-hour special hosted by Geraldo Rivera creates a trial of Lee Harvey Oswald. (Nov. 22-23, syndicated, check listings)

VIDEO ▶ *John F. Kennedy: The Commemorative Video Album*. CBS News' footage narrated by Reasoner, Rather and Cronkite. (CBS/Fox Video, \$19.98)

▶ *JFK Remembered*. A 54-minute rebroadcast of an *ABC News Close-Up Special* focusing on JFK's 1,000 days in office. (Vestron Video, \$19.98)
