Cuban twist to JFK assassination

The same group of mobsters and right-wingers that tried repeatedly to kill Cuban leader Fidel Castro was behind the assassination of President John F. Kennedy, according to a Cuban TV program. Z-RIFLE identified five people—three American mobsters and two anti-Castro Cubans—as being directly responsible for the 1963 shooting, the Cuban government news agency, Prensa Latina, reported Saturday. The Warren Commission concluded in 1964 that Lee Harvey Oswald acted alone.
