## No conspiracy to kill JFK, Clinton asserts

President Clinton, on the 30th anniversary of John F. Kennedy's assassination, joined the minority of Americans who say there was no conspiracy. Clinton said he's "satisfied with the finding that Lee Harvey Oswald acted alone."

Among 25,000 visitors Monday to Kennedy's grave at Arlington National Cemetery were his brother, Sen. Edward Kennedy and nephew, Rep. Joseph Kennedy.

In Dallas, Nellie Connally, widow of Texas governor John Connally, who was wounded in the shooting, unveiled a plaque marking Dealey Plaza as a National Historic Landmark.

Twin fighters thundered above and white doves were released at the same time Kennedy was shot 30 years ago.
