## Oswald widow to clear up tale

The former wife of Lee Harvey Oswald wants the truth out and the past behind her in an TV movie on her life.

Marina Oswald Porter was 22 and spoke little English when Oswald was charged with killing President Kennedy. She says she hopes the NBC-TV movie "Fatal Deception" that will air Nov. 15 will help her quest for closure.
