ASK'93 is proud to have Pulitzer Prize-winning author Norman Mailer as our Keynote Speaker.

Mr. Mailer is in the process of completing a new book about Lee Harvey Oswald, and is considered to be not only one of the great American writers of the 20th Century, but also one of the most astute contemporary participant/observers of the social, cultural and political events of the past three decades. He was also a co-founder of *The Village Voice*.

HYATT ROOMS

The Hyatt Regency Dallas at Reunion is the closest hotel to Dealey Plaza. Many rooms overlook the assassination site including the Plaza, railroad yards, and the Dal-Tex Building. Deadline for hotel reservations has passed, but rooms may still be available. The hotel may honor the discounted rate if you refer to the ASK Meeting, but this also depends on availability. The discounted rates are:
