Since its inception in 1991, the Assassination Symposium on Kennedy (ASK) has provided an opportunity and a platform for concerned citizens and researchers from across the U.S. and around the world to lay out their individual pieces of the puzzle. ASK hopes to be a vehicle to allow those pieces to come together in a cogent manner that can facilitate finding truth as well as spotlighting needed changes in government policy and procedures.
