9:30 last night AP Baltimore phoned me under instructions from NY. Apparently the NYT news story alerted AP. We talked a long time. This pm phoned me back, seemingly interested in only two things: had I been in Dallas and had I seen Hughes film, plus relationship with Dick Sprague.

If they move anything that you see in your area, please send it. I have no reason to expect anything good from AP, especially now. They appear not to have moved a story on their radio wire or the station in Frederick would have had it and I'd have heard. The local thing is one they'd not likely miss if they did move something.

We're temporarily out of books. The bindery broke down. It was to have been repaired Friday p.m., to work Saturday, to get my wholesale orders to NY out and in NYC by midday Wednesday, and I can only hope and wait.

Having no books to package I've been working on the next one, and I fear I may again have to subdivide. Putting the appendix together, without finishing it I have 300 pages pasted up now! By the end of the coming week I'll have that done and I hope have decided.

From the reaction of the European correspondents I have spoken to, including the one who got here today just in time to share a goose with us, the use of the documents is impressive. There may be a good reaction abroad that may feed back.
