On April 20, at the request of your Baltimore office, I sent
AP two pictures relevant to the assassination of Martin Luther King
and its investigation.

They have never been returned and I have never been paid for
them.

You have two pictures I would like to have. I propose an even
swap. These are two pictures of Oswald with a rifle, NY 51, 12/20/64
and 112/18/64.

That these were sent AP at the request of the Baltimore office
can be confirmed by the city editor of your local paper, Bob Harper,
who phoned your Baltimore office when I showed him the photos. He also
supplied the envelope in which I mailed them and the address.
