Ford Hits Concepts Of Nixon

o Mr. Ford appeared perturbed when asked whether he agreed with Nixon that in the questioner's words, "It is all right for a Presi-dent to break the law in

certain circumstances."
"I don't agree," said the President, raising his voice

slightly.
