Owing to my own peculiar relationship with him I should like to ask that you not do so. Of course, if you can develop this piece of data from some other source I should like for you to do so. However, please do not associate my name with it. Of course you realize I will have to live which him for some time to come in a quasi-professional relationship. I had invited him to visit us and give a lecture to our students but he declined and I am sure it is in part to my interest in the autopsy.
