Researchers into the assessination

Many believe there was a conspiracy to murder Kennsdy and have written books detailing scientific and political "evidence" of the alleged plot. In a statement, the group said mem-bers were dismayed to learn the for-mer Soviet Union's KGB filso on al-leged JFK assassin Lee Harvey Ou-

wald might be released before equivalent CIA documents.

Judge, who maintained government agencies not only destroyed physical evidence but "planted false evidence, said the sealed documents "owned and paid for by the American people, constitute the history of our country, not a commodity owned by the state."

Current legislation in Congress is far from the full disclosure members would like, but millions of pages of documents exist, and even restricted releases will reveal the truth, the group says.
