

## **Lincoln Autopsy Report Fails to Give Bullet Path**

CHICAGO, July 30 (AP)—A recently discovered autopsy report by Abraham Lincoln's personal physician has not settled the controversy over whether the fatal bullet entered the right or left side of Lincoln's head.

This is the conclusion of Dr. John Lattimer of Columbia University in the current Journal of the American Medical Association.

After Lincoln's assassination, some observers swore that the bullet fired by John Wilkes Booth entered the left side of the head. Others said it entered the right temple.

The report by Dr. Robert King Stone clearly states that the bullet "lodged in cerebral matter . . . on the left side." However, Dr. Lattimer contended, his accompanying diagram does not make this clear.
